#### 8. Village Hall

Work to the toilet has been completed. A cleaner has been appointed for the Village Hall. Cllr D Teasdale informed the meeting he is on the building sub committee.

#### 9. Church update

The disabled toilet inside the Church has been re-furbished to make it better suited to wheelchair users at a cost of £3550. This amount was met by money raised by the Church and half provided by a grant from the National Churches Trust. The Church is about to apply for planning permission to render the tower.

## 10. Askrigg Foundation Building

Planning has been approved for two flats and one cottage. A massive clear out of the building had been undertaken and the building is now empty.

### 11. Healthwatch

The Clerk had sent a letter on behalf of the Parish Council to Rishi Sunak MP. Cllr Fawcett informed the meeting of the response back which acknowledged the concerns raised.

#### 12. Cemetery

Cllr. Fawcett raised concerns about the number of rabbits in the Cemetery which were causing a problem. A 'tidy up' meeting would be arranged.

## 13. School boundary fence

The working group continue to meet to take forward the work on the boundary fence.

Local resident, Jill Leslie, told the meeting that since signage had been put up, in the most problematic areas, fouling had gone down. She will continue to monitor the situation.

Cllr. Fawcett and the Clerk had met with a representative from North Yorkshire County Council and identified where the matrix could be positioned. It was agreed to purchase one for the village and the Clerk agreed to contact the supplier. Initially, it would be positioned along Station Road near the school.
